



SPHS BASEBALL BOOSTER CLUB 2018 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INFO

PURPOSE: The purpose of the SPHS Baseball Scholarship is to recognize accomplishments of senior Tiger baseball players.

AMOUNT OF AWARDS: The total amount of the scholarships awarded varies from year to year based upon available funds from the SPHS Tiger Baseball Booster Club. Furthermore, the amounts awarded to the individual players will be divided among the eligible players who correctly complete all of the Scholarship Eligibility Criteria outlined on this application within the specified deadline.

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY:

1. The senior player must have been in the SPHS Baseball Program for a minimum of two years, one of which must be his senior year.
2. The senior player must have their counselor complete the portion of the application requiring the verification of GPA and that they are on schedule to complete all requirements necessary for graduation.
3. The senior player must complete the SPHS Baseball Booster Club 2018 Scholarship Application and submit to the SPHS Head Baseball Coach or designee, by the deadline date.

DEADLINE: The SPHS Baseball Booster Club 2018 Scholarship Application must be turned in by Friday, April 13th, 2018 to the Head Baseball Coach Office or designee.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Scholarships are one time awards/payments, valid for two years from the date of the award. If not used within two years, the recipient forfeits the scholarship in its entirety.
- The Scholarship Committee is comprised of non-senior SPHS Baseball Booster Club parents who will review and score the submitted scholarship applications.
- Scholarships will be awarded at the SPHS Senior Awards Assembly.

SPHS TIGER BASEBALL BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA/MATRIX

1. The Senior player must have been in the SPHS Baseball Program a minimum of two years, one of which must be his senior year.
2. The senior player must have an overall grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or higher at the end of the fall semester in his senior year.
3. The senior player must plan to attend a two year or a four-year school after graduation from SPHS.
4. The senior player must complete the SPHS Baseball Booster Club Application and submit by the stated deadline.
